**Arrangement:** Items were originally stored in four boxes and two binders. Items originally stored in the four boxes are arranged in series by item or subject type and then chronologically. Items originally stored in the two binders are arranged in series according to the binder's subject and then chronologically, these include the two series titled Gainsboro Steering Committee and Washington Park Improvements and Monument Committee. Documents numbered and notated with a pencil marked \* indicates multiple items that were originally stapled or paper clipped together by the collection's creator. The collection is broken into eleven (11) series: Correspondences and Related Items, Economics / Finances, Gainsboro Neighborhood History, Gainsboro on the National Register, Historic Preservation, News Clippings, Notes, Gainsboro Steering Committee, Personal Life, Washington Park Improvements and Monument Committee, and Photographs. **Addendum:** Items were originally stored in five boxes and eight binders. All items are arranged in series by item or subject type and then chronologically. Oversized Record Storage Box is item level organization. Documents numbered and notated with a pencil marked \* indicates multiple items that were originally stapled or paper clipped together by the collection's creator. There are fourteen (14) additional series: City Council, Correspondences, Finances, Gainsboro Branch Roanoke Public Library, Gainsboro Preservation, H-2 (National Register - State and National Level), Henry Street, HGPD, Notes, People, Places, RNDC, Roanoke Preservation, and Wells Avenue Project.

**Biographical Note:**

Evelyn Davis Bethel was born on 5 June 1933 to Edmond and Agnes Davis in Roanoke, Virginia. Bethel's family resided on Patton Avenue Northeast in the Gainsboro Neighborhood. Bethel had five brothers, James, Herbert, Roy, Curtis, and Clarence, and one sister, Helen, whom she worked with extensively in the latter part of her life. Evelyn Davis married John W. Bethel in 1955, and they had no children.

Evelyn Davis Bethel graduated from Lucy Addison High School in 1951, and then she left Roanoke to pursue a collegiate education. Bethel studied at Virginia Union University where she earned her degree in Sociology in 1955. She also completed some post-graduate studies at American University in Washington D.C. Bethel started her career as a Clerk Typist with the Navy in D.C., but then joined the Social Security Administration in cities like Detroit, Michigan and Baltimore, Maryland.

After the death of her husband, Evelyn Davis Bethel returned to Gainsboro in the early 1990s where she planned to enjoy a leisurely retirement. Upon her return, Bethel noticed the effects Urban Renewal had upon her hometown, and that's when she decided to make some changes in the community. In 1991, Bethel created, and presided over, the Historic Gainsboro Preservation District, Inc. Some major projects that Evelyn spearheaded include:

- Petitioning against the Wells Avenue expansion from 1991 - 1993
- Arranging for Gainsboro to be recognized as an H-2 historic district in 1996
- Getting Gainsboro on the National Register of Historic Places in 1996 (completed in 2005)
- Moving two houses as part of Operation Rebirth in 1997
- Renaming previous streets "Gainsboro Road" from 1999 - 2000
- Renaming an already standing bridge "Gainsboro Bridge" in 2000
- Presiding over the Roanoke Valley Preservation Foundation in 2000
- Participating in the Washington Park Improvements and Monument Committee from 2000 - 2005
- Taking part in the Gainsboro Steering Committee from 2003 - 2006
- Running for City Council in 2006
- Protesting the Henry Street Social Security Building from 2006 - 2007.

In 2018, Evelyn Davis Bethel and her sister, Helen Davis, were honored by the Gainsboro Public Library at an event named, "An Evening Honoring Evelyn Bethel and Helen Davis." At the event, Bethel and Davis were honored for their lifetime commitment to historic preservation and the Gainsboro community. And then, in 2019, the Virginia General Assembly passed a resolution commending Evelyn Davis Bethel and Helen Davis for their work as historic preservationists and community leaders. The Roanoke Valley Preservation Foundation honored Bethel and Davis with a "Lifetime Achievement Award" in 2020 for their work in preserving African American history, and now the Foundation has an annual award entitled, "Evelyn Davis Bethel Award for the Preservation of African American Heritage."

Evelyn Davis Bethel died on 23 June 2020, only eighteen days after her 87th birthday.

### **Scope and Content:**

- Evelyn Davis Bethel Papers Collection consists of three (3) record storage boxes.
- The collection consists of notes, correspondences, newspaper clippings, signage, official government documents, photographs, and other documentation of her various civil rights actions.
  - Please use the notes, correspondences, and news clippings series' to supplement information found in other series. These series offer cultural, personal, and communal background to the information found elsewhere in the collection.
- There are eleven (11) series found in the collection: Correspondences and Related Items, Economics / Finances, Gainsboro Neighborhood History, Gainsboro on the National Register, Historic Preservation, News Clippings, Notes, Gainsboro Steering Committee, Personal Life, Washington Park Improvements and Monument Committee, and Photographs.
  - Each series is further broken down into as many folders as necessary regarding more specific topics under the broader series title.
- This collection primarily regards Evelyn Davis Bethel's work on the Historic Preservation of Gainsboro.
- The dates from this collection consist predominantly of the years 1991 to 2018 with some news clippings dated from 1882.

## **Addendum Scope and Contents:**

- The Addendum of the Evelyn Davis Bethel Papers Collection consists of four (4) record storage boxes, and one (1) oversized record storage box.
- The addendum consists of the same materials as in the original collection.
- There are fourteen (14) additional series: City Council, Correspondences, Finances, Gainsboro Branch Roanoke Public Library, Gainsboro Preservation, H-2 (National Register - State and National Level), Henry Street, HGPD, Notes, People, Places, RNDC, Roanoke Preservation, and Wells Avenue Project
  - The addendum is also broken down into folder-level.
- The addendum maintains the same focus of Evelyn Davis Bethel's work regarding the Historic Preservation of Gainsboro.
- The addendum predominantly consists of the years 1991-2015 with some documents dating back to 1950's.
- Oversized Record Storage Box is item level organization.
